Enrolment and work submission can be made online. Contestants will be given a FTP log-in account name and password upon the completion of online enrolment. Contestants will be required to submit all related contents to the FTP on or before 30 July 2012, at 23:59 Hong Kong time(GMT+8). Submission time will be recorded by the server; any late submission will not be accepted.

Contestants should submit the following files and documents:

- 1. Final Entry: a compile program (ipa file for iPhone or apk file for Android) with any related files and source files necessary for execution including source codes, header files, library files, graphics, data files and other related files, methods or commands used for compilation. If the submission is an installation file, it is not required to have digitally signed.
- 2. Work description: a text description of no more than 300 characters in Chinese or 500 words in English for concept elaboration and three presentative screen shots.
- 3. Video demo: no more than 10 minutes for APP demonstration.
